

Privacy Policy

Dear User

The document, that you are reading, constitutes the privacy policy of Thulium System's website, hereinafter referred to as Website, available under the address: <http://thulium.pl>. The Website is run by THULIUM SPÓŁKA Z OGRANICZONĄ ODPOWIEDZIALNOŚCIĄ, hereinafter referred to as the Administrator. We care about your privacy and we want you to feel comfortable using our services. That's why below we present the most important information about the rules of us processing your personal data and cookies used by our Website.

Personal data and privacy

If you are going to create a User Account and use our services, you will be asked to provide your personal data. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to use our services – due to the character of these services. The administrator of your personal data is the Administrator.

Remember, that in any moment you can object to further data processing for marketing purposes. To revoke your consent, you only need to contact us.

Moreover, you have the right to review the content of data, that concerns you, you can also demand correcting it at any time.

While processing your data, we use organizational and technical means pursuant to Polish legislation and we use SSL encrypted connections.
